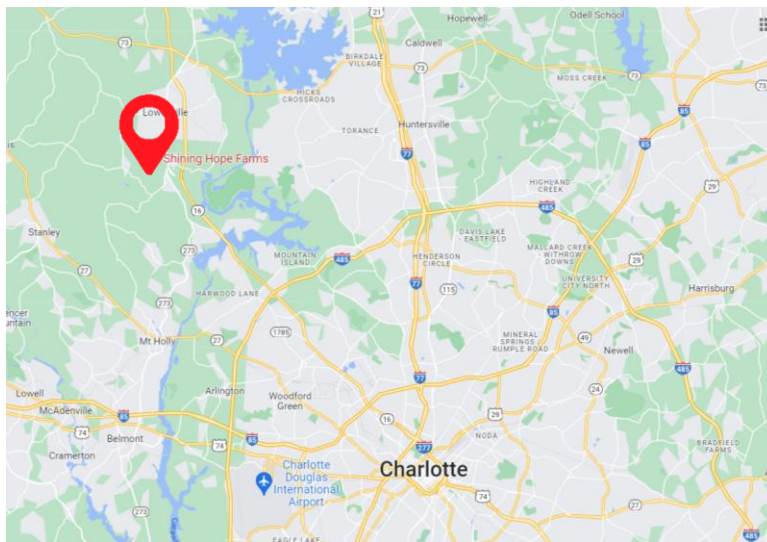

## Description of Project

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Pole holders are designed to hold ground poles at the side of the ring when not in use or during dragging the ring.

Ground poles are painted poles that we use for training horses. They are also used as a tool for the therapist to use with the clients. They can be utilized as a matching game, color recognition, speech therapy sounding out the colors.

## Description of Project

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This project involves removing 336' of old wire fencing and replacing it with new 3 rail wood fencing in the pasture. The wood fencing will protect the horses from injuries and cuts possible with the old wire fencing.

- Removal of wire fencing first



- Holes will be drilled with the tractor and the post hole digger
- Posts will be set in ½ of 60 lb bag of quick setting cement
- Use post level for each post
- Post tops will be cut at an angle for water run off at the end of the project

## Description of Project

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The erosion from recent rain storms on the road to the sensory trail and the sensory trail itself have caused ditches and exposed roots to develop that are a liability for the horses

and therapists. The pit gravel would help to smooth out the road and the trail by improving the footing for anyone using the sensory trail during a session.
